TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. All alcoholic beverages being served or consumed must be provided by the club and consumed in the club. Alcohol cannot be taken outside the building. This is to meet the regulations of our liquor licence. If bottles of wine are on the tables, there is a \$5 corking fee for each bottle.
- 2. The event will be conducted in an orderly and proper manner with no unlawful activity.
- 3. All exits shall not be obstructed.
- 4. When candles are used, they must be placed in non-flammable containers with the flame not exceeding the top of the container.
- 5. Any decorations placed for the rental shall be removed at the conclusion of the event and must be non-damaging. No scotch tape, only blue painters tape on painted surfaces, no screws or nails are to be used. No confetti is to be used in the club.
- 6. The screen divider is provided in three sections, please handle with care. You may add your own coloured material with push pins or tacks on the top of the wood area only.
- 7. Entertainment must stop at 1:00 a.m. All persons are to be out of the building by 1:30 a.m.

Liability Waiver:

- 1. The applicant hereby assumes all responsibility for any injury however caused by the applicant or guests to any person or damage to neighbouring lands, structures or personal property and shall save harmless the Stirling Curling Club, its agents and employees from any and all claims. All players on the ice must sign the Liability Waiver supplied by the Curling Club.
- 2. The applicant further assumes all responsibility for any damage to the property therein, caused by the applicant or guests. Such damage may be repaired by the Stirling Curling Club or under its direction and, in such event, the applicant shall pay to the Stirling Curling Club all costs of such repairs, including the value of labour and services provided by the Stirling Curling Club itself.

Winter Season Special Considerations:

1. Footwear: When people arrive--and this means *everyone*, whether you go on the ice or not--you take off your outdoor footwear.

When you come through the door, you are on carpet. The carpet area is where you take off your outdoor footwear, and put it in one of the spaces along the wall. Do *not* put on your curling shoes while still on the carpet. The shoes would just pick up the dirt from the outdoor shoes and carry it inside. If you're not curling, you may bring clean indoor shoes or slippers, or go in your socks.

Carry your curling shoes and other gear inside and find a chair where you can sit and put on your curling shoes. Men's and women's change rooms are available, if desired.

Finally, as you go through the door to the ice, step with both feet on the sticky mats, to remove any dirt from your curling shoes.

Curler don't need to have official curling shoes. Clean running shoes with a rubber sole will do fine. We have sliders which fit under the shoe, so that can curlers can deliver their rocks in the normal way. But the key word is clean. Those shoes must not have any dirt on them; preferably shoes which are never worn outdoors.

The goal is to stop as much dirt as possible right at the entrance. The reason we are so fanatical about this is that even a tiny pebble which gets on the ice can scratch the stones, and make them behave erratically.

2. Children in the Stirling Curling Club MUST be accompanied by an adult at all times and are not allowed to play on the ice surface.
